

Ooltewah Shopping Center Sells For \$5.6 Million

Wolftever Crossing Shopping Strip, a 12,040-square-foot retail property located in Ooltewah sold for \$5.6 million, or \$465 per square-foot. The property was brokered by Marcus & Millichap.

Wolftever Crossing Shopping Strip, built in 2017, is located at 9032 Old Lee Hwy. The property shares an intersection with Walmart Supercenter and is located adjacent to Chick-fil-A, Zaxby's and Panda Express. The asset features two buildings with national tenants including AT&T, Supercuts, Salsarita's and Firehouse Subs, along with a standalone AFC Urgent Care building.
